## Resources

### Career Center

Engages students in career conversations to help you understand what brought you to college, how you can build experiences and relationships, and to realize your professional potential.

### Center for Identity and Inclusion

Supports underrepresented students and promotes a diverse and inclusive campus for all students, faculty, and staff. Consists of American Indian Student Services (AISS), Asian American Student Services (AASS), Black Student Services (BSS), Latinx Student Services (LSS), Undocumented Student Services, and the Women and Gender Center.

### International Student & Scholar Services

ISSS provides immigration and advising services for F-1 or J-1 student visas, J-1 exchange scholar visas, H-1B temporary worker visas, lawful permanent resident visas, and LPR-employment-based visas.

### Loving Lynx

Loving Lynx is an emergency funding resource available to CU Denver students dealing with unanticipated events you can also contact the Dean of Students Office to discuss whether your situation constitutes an unanticipated event.

### Single Stop

Single Stop at CU Denver connects students to the local community and governmental resources that can help them overcome socioeconomic barriers and assist them in their educational journey.

### Veteran and Military Support Services

The Office of Veteran and Military Student Services (VMSS) supports veteran, active duty, reservist, national guard, and dependent students.

### Counseling Center

Private and confidential mental health services, 6-12 session model.

### Dean of Students Office

Dean of Students Office supports the CU Denver community by advocating for students, addressing concerns, and promoting wellness and accountability

### Disability Resource Office

Dedicated to the full participation of students with disabilities in the university environment.

### Financial Aid

Supports conversations around the types of aid, applications for financial aid, and answering financial aid questions.

### First Year Experiences and Peer Advocate Leaders

PALS provide peer-level support that promotes student achievement, growth, and learning through the student's career at CU Denver. They are trained to work with students to connect them with CU Denver, the Auraria Campus, and the Denver community. PALs are paired in First-Year Experience courses to plan and facilitate educational and social activities.

### Learning Resource Center

The Learning Resources Center (LRC) is designed to promote student success, retention, and graduation in the academic setting. We provide several different services designed to help students explore the learning process, strengthen their time management skills, and evolve in their understanding of course content. The LRC offers study groups, supplemental learning sessions, study skills workshops and individual learning coaching appointments.

### Resources for Immigrant Students and ELL

RISE is an academic and social support program that has a goal to support immigrant and English Language Learners at CU Denver by providing them with one-on-one meetings in which they can talk about their academic needs and/or work on developing their English skills
