

Peer Advocate Leader (PAL) FAQs

- 1) What is a PAL?
 - a. A PAL is a trained student staff member who works to connect one-on-one with our FYE students and in their FYE courses. PALs provide ongoing mentorship both inside and outside the classroom during a student's first fall semester and help students get connected and involved in the CU Denver campus community. PALs create and host events for students, attend campus-wide events, support their students in their FYE class, and act as a resource for their FYE students.
- 2) How do I get a PAL?

- 3) Can I be a PAL?
 - a. Being a PAL is a paid student staff position – we welcome anyone interested in applying! Applications for being a PAL typically open in the spring semester for the upcoming fall term.
