Welcome David Gamble!



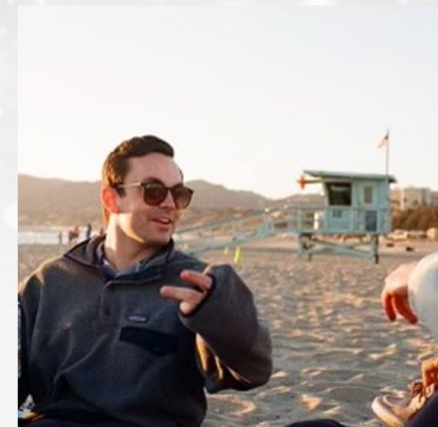

Welcome Shennon Lu



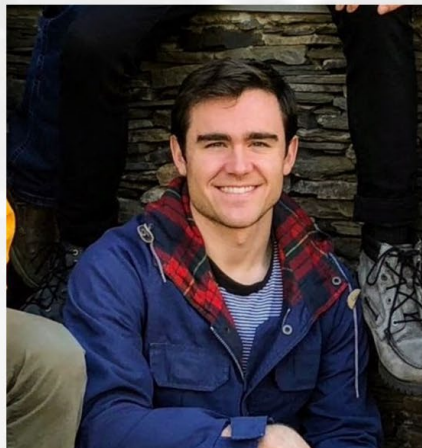
